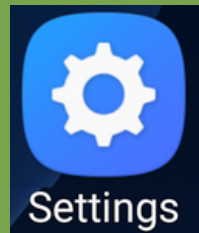
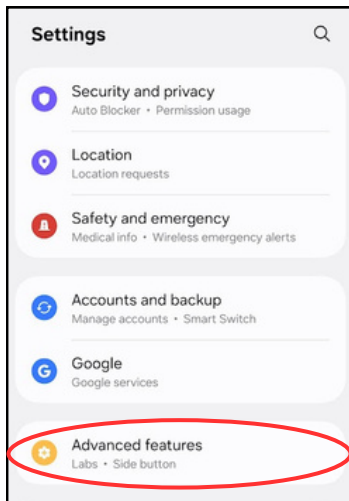
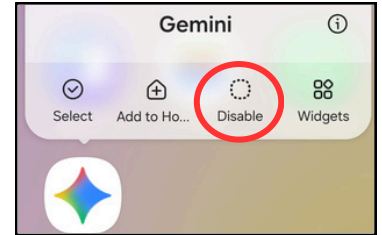


AVOIDING AI: ANDROID

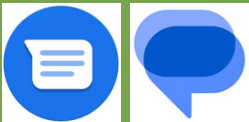
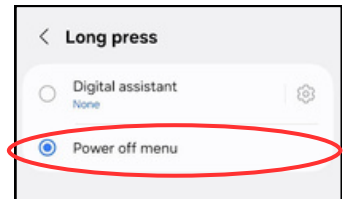
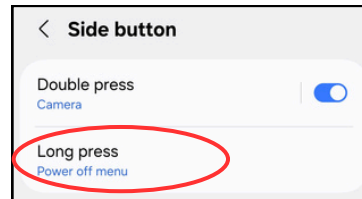
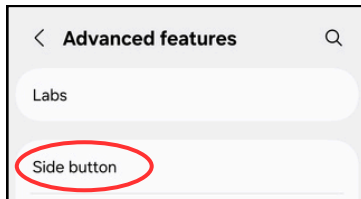
Android phones have **Gemini** in their operating system and in the Messages app. To remove:

Check your list of apps

If you see **Gemini**, press and hold on the icon
Select Delete, Uninstall, Remove, or Disable



Open your **Settings** app
Scroll and select **Advanced features**
Tap **Side button**
Tap **Long press**
Select **Power off menu**



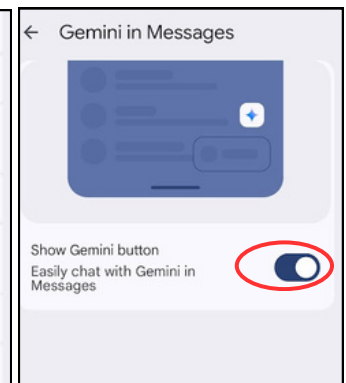
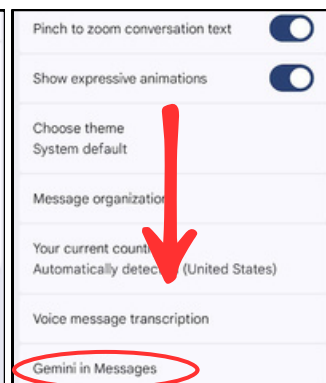
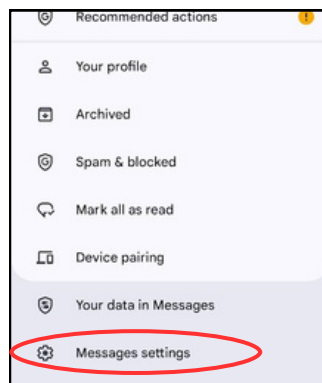
Open Google's **Messages** app
Tap your **picture or initial** in the top right



Select **Messages settings**

Scroll down and tap **Gemini in Messages**

Toggle **Show Gemini** button to off position
