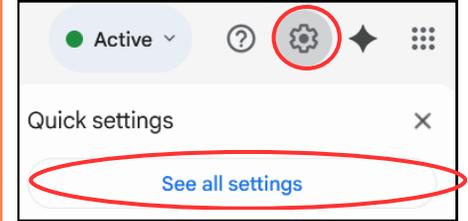


AVOIDING AI: GMAIL

Gmail tries to integrate Google's **Gemini** AI tool, along with other "smart" features that invade your privacy. To disable:

In Gmail's webmail, click the **Gear Icon** at upper right and select **See all settings**

Or on mobile, tap the menu icon on top left and the gear icon at the bottom of the list.

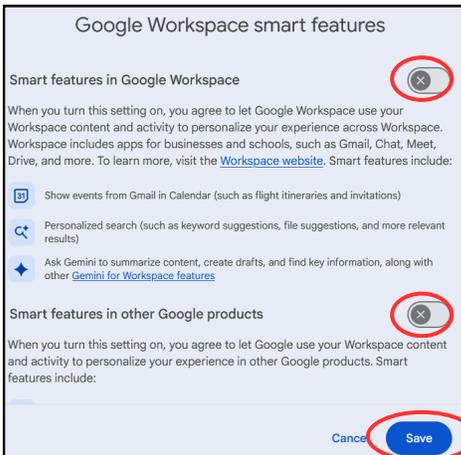

Scroll down and select **Manage Workspace smart feature settings**

Toggle off **both switches** and click **Save**

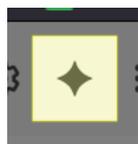
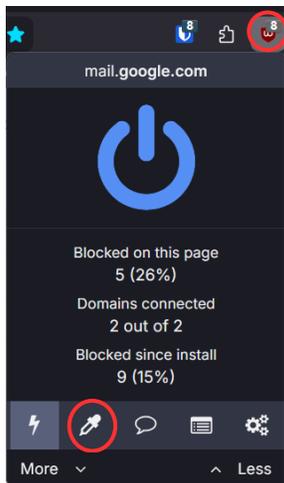


Optional: Find **Smart features** in the settings list and uncheck the box

Smart features: Turn on smart features in Gmail, Chat, and Meet - When you turn this setting on, you agree to let Gmail, Chat, and Meet use your content and activity in these products to provide smart features and personalize your experience. [Learn more](#)

This disables *all* "smart" features in Gmail, including categorizing mail, autogenerated suggested responses, autocorrect, & "nudges." You can uncheck these individually if you prefer.

Optional: To remove the **Gemini logo** from Gmail's webmail, you can use an extension like **uBlock Origin**. Visit ublockorigin.com to download & install



Click the **logo** at top right, then the **eye dropper**. **Highlight** the Gemini icon and **click** to block, selecting **Create** on the pop-up (you may have to repeat several times for it to fully disappear)
