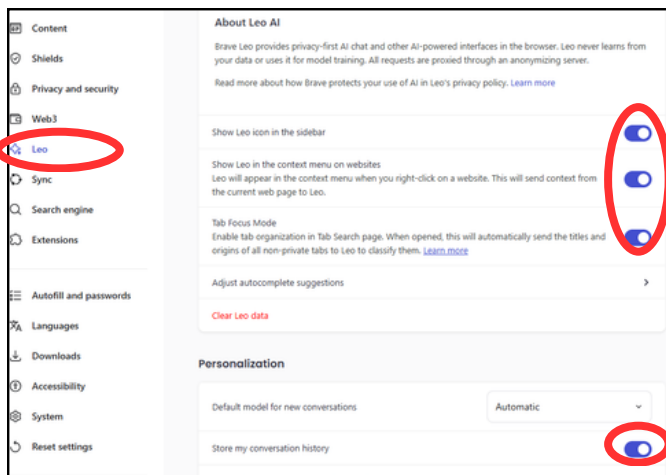


AVOIDING AI: BRAVE (DESKTOP)

Many web browsers are integrating intrusive AI features. Some are easier to disable than others. **Brave web browser has some good privacy settings and makes it possible to disable all AI features:**



Open Brave
Click three lines in upper right corner
Go to Settings

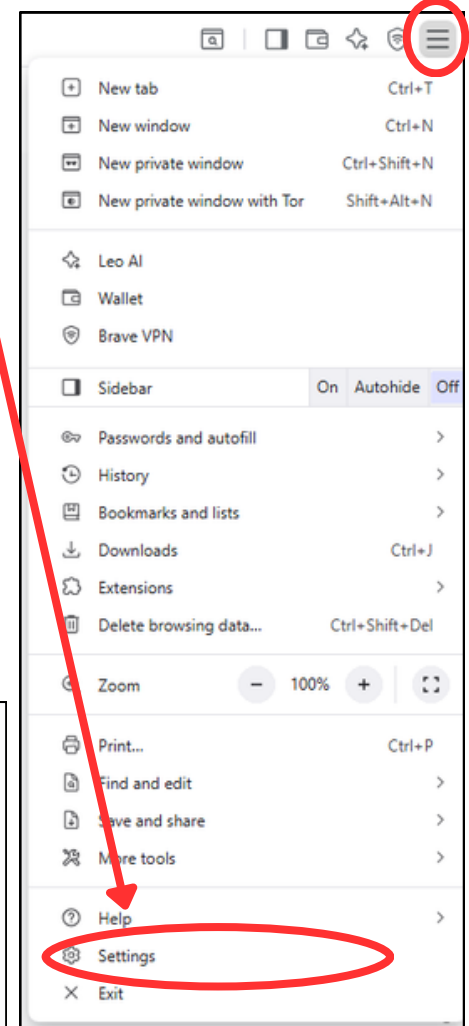
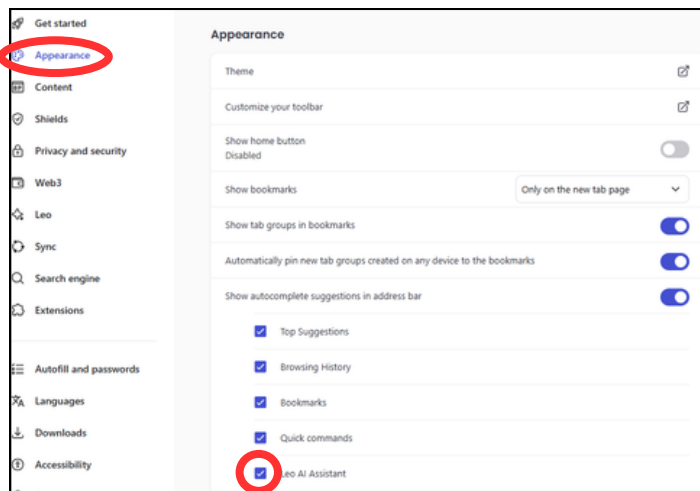


Select **Leo** on

Note: your **web browser** is different from your **search engine**. You'll have to take other steps to disable AI in your search engine.
