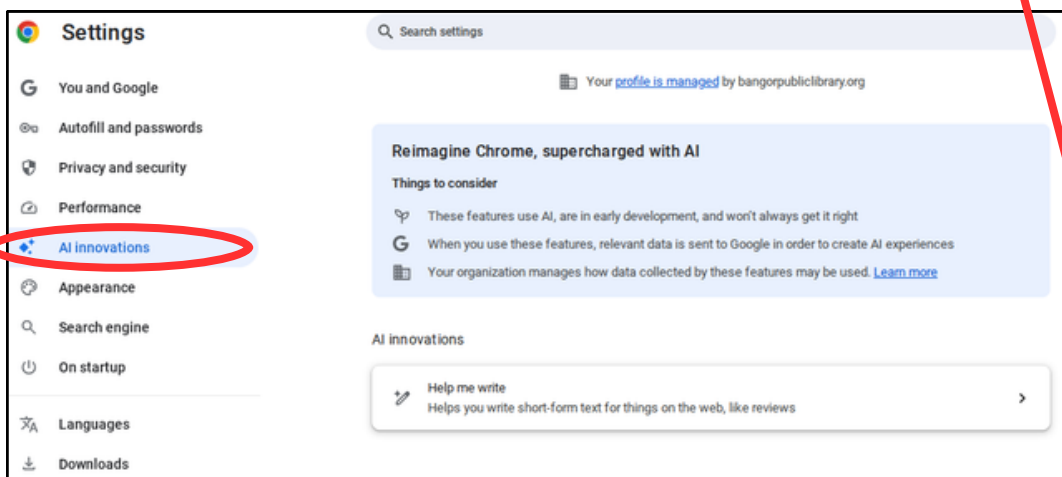


AVOIDING AI: CHROME (DESKTOP)

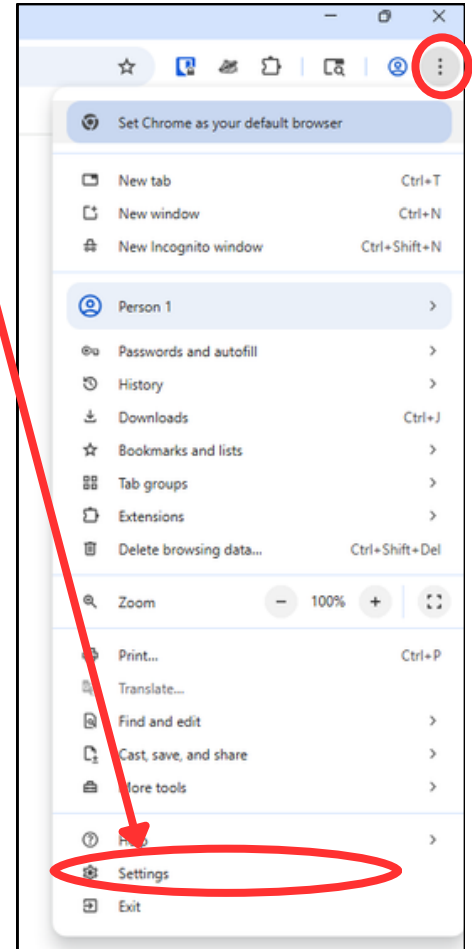
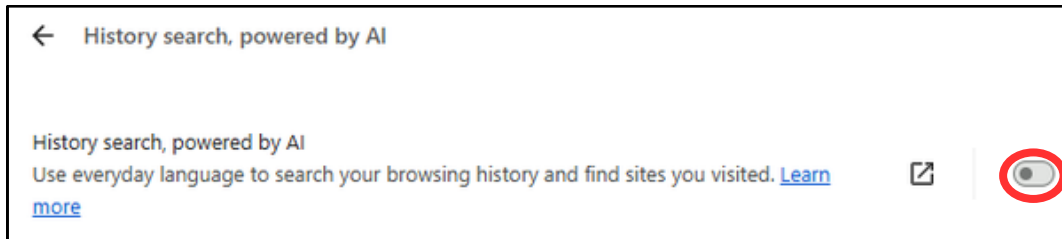
Many web browsers are integrating intrusive AI features. Some are easier to disable than others. Google Chrome is a popular browser, but not good for privacy. Consider switching to a more private browser, or **if you stick with Chrome, disable AI** where you can:



Open **Chrome**
Click **three dots** in upper right corner
Go to **Settings**



Select **AI Innovations** on left-hand sidebar
Click each item on the list and **switch to Off**



Note: your **web browser** is different from your **search engine**. You'll have to take other steps to disable AI in your search engine.

WHY AVOID AI?

Generative AI is a source of misinformation, and is rife with labor, environmental, and social concerns. It's being pushed by big technology companies through forced adoption by design.
