

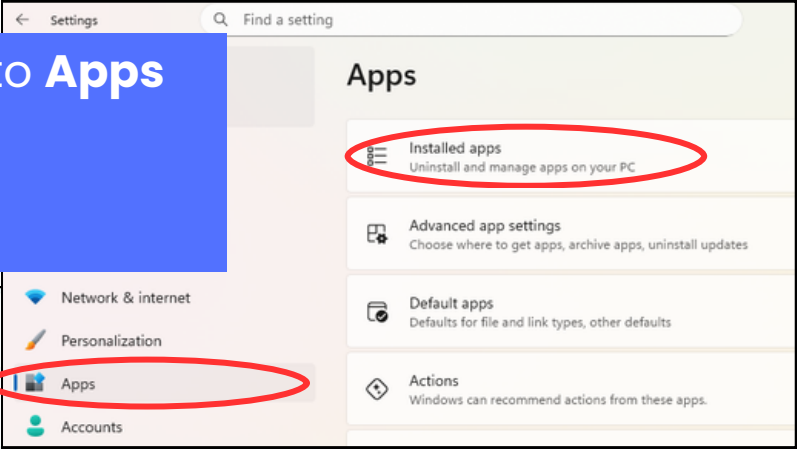
AVOIDING AI: WINDOWS 11

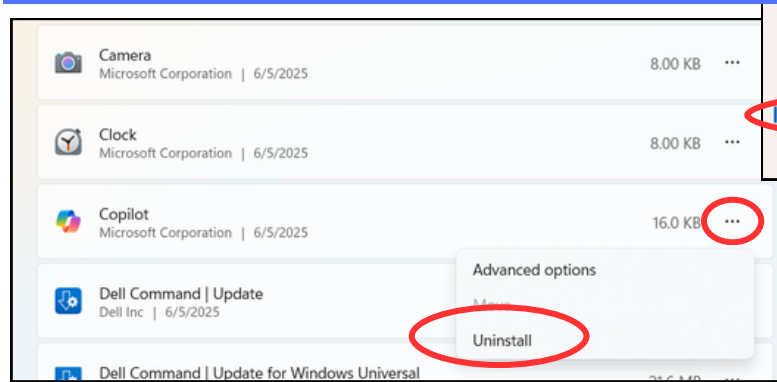
Windows 11 comes with **Copilot** and **Microsoft 365 Copilot** installed. Older computers may still have **Cortana**. Security permissions may allow generative AI access to your apps. To remove:



Open **Settings** and go to **Apps** (lefthand sidebar)

Click **Installed Apps**





Scroll to **Copilot**, **Cortana**, or **Microsoft 365 Copilot**

Click the **three dots** to the right of each AI app

Select **Uninstall**

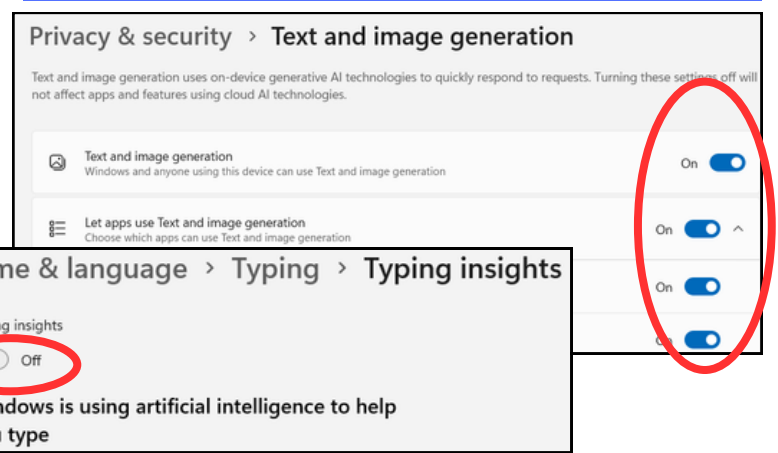
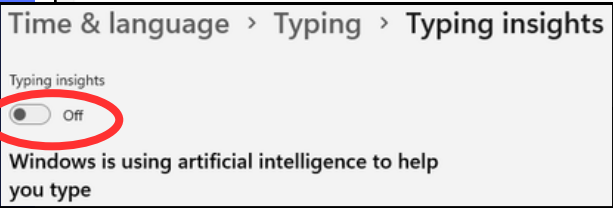
In **Settings** go to **Privacy & security** (left sidebar)

Scroll to **Text and image generation**

Turn off all permissions

Also in **Settings** go to **Time & language** (left sidebar)

Click **Typing insights** and turn **off**

WHY AVOID AI?
